- 4. When a locked Layout viewport is activated, to what color does its edges turn?
 - a. Red
- 5. To prevent a viewport from appearing on a plot or print, what workflow would you employ?
 - **d**. Place the viewport on a non-plotting layer.
- 6. If you want to create a three-view orthographic projection of your model in a Layout, what is the advantage of choosing a four-view setup instead of a three-view setup?
